A WARNING

- Unplug the fan before moving it or performing maintenance. Do not touch the fan when your hands are wet.
- 2. Those who are not qualified electricians should not disassemble, repair or rebuild the fan.
- 3. Unplug the fan when it is not in use.
- 4. DO NOT unplug the fan by holding the cable cord. Unplug by holding the plug.
- 5. DO NOT use the fan when there is damage to the cable cord or plug.

OPERTATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place the fan on a safe, flat surface where it cannot fall or be pulled by the cord.
- To adjust the height, loosen the height adjusting ring. Hold the inner tube and stand on the edge of the base. Pull up or press down on the inner tube. Do not adjust by holding onto the fan head. Tighten the height adjusting ring at the desire height.
- Select desired direction of air flow by adjusting the tilting adjusting knob.

Note: Always switch the fan off when adjusting the height or tilt angle.

- 4. Turn the rotary switch for desired speed. 0=Off, 1=Low, 2=Med., 3=High
- Turn the oscillation function on by pressing the oscillation button down. Turn the oscillation function off by pulling the oscillation button up.
- 6. Always turn off and unplug the fan after using.

DO NOT depend upon the on-off switch as the sole means of disconnecting power when installing or servicing the fan. Always unplug the power cord.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Unplug the appliance before cleaning. Don't use any water for cleaning metal surfaces. Using a soft cloth wipe off the surfaces of the fan. In order to remove the dust from the grill, use a vacuum cleaner or remove the front grill by removing the securing screw on the edge of the grill with a screwdriver. After cleaning, remount the grill. Then fasten the securing screws on the edge of the grill.

STAND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Attach the outer tube to the base with 4 screws as shown.

A CAUTION

The screws must be fully tightened before the fan operates.



Step 2

Slide the height adjustable ring away from outer tube. Saving it for Step 3.




Step 3

Put the height adjustable ring into the inner tube. Then put it into outer tube and fasten the height adjustable ring for your desired height of fan.







